Kigali

Kigali is the flourishing and fascinating Rwanda's capital, one of the cleanest cities in Africa and maybe in the world.

Vibrant markets offer handicrafts including traditional Rwandan basketware, coffee that is locally produced and tasty fruits.

Not to be missed a visit to the Kigali Genocide Memorial that serves as a moving reminder of the 800,000 people who were murdered during Rwanda's 1994 genocide.

Volcanoes National Park

The Volcanoes National Park is the place to be, the perfect destination to search the



endangered great apes hiding in the misty forests on the slopes of the Virunga volcanoes.

The Rwanda's majestic volcanoes with their lush vegetation are home to hundreds of species of trees, plants and birds and, of course, the impressive mountain gorillas.

Tracking the gorillas on foot is for many travellers a lifetime dream come true and make acquaintances with a silverback amidst the lush jungle is a thrill experience.



Akagera National Park

The Akagera National Park is home to a unique swamp ecosystem that is one of the **largest protected wetland areas in Eastern Africa**, the park is characterized by open savannas, woodlands, lakes, damp swamps, and grassy low mountains.

A 4×4 safari tour across unspoiled savannah and thriving plains, or a boat safari on the lake, allows to observe a large range of wildlife: elephants, antelopes, Nile crocodiles and one of Africa's highest hippos population.



Akagera now also boasts a healthy population of lions as well as black rhinos, the park also harbours a good density of <u>leopards</u> and the elusive sitatunga.

The Akagera National Park is home to 500 different species of bird, including the rare shoebill, making it a true birdwatchers paradise.
