Hwange National Park


Hwange National Park is the largest national park of the country, its territories are abounding and rich in undisturbed wildlife to be found in the teak forest and sand veld.

The Hwange protects a **huge amount of elephants and buffalos** as well as large pride of lions, leopards, wild dogs, gemsboks, packs of brown hyenas and a variety of antelope species.

The Hwange is a **birdwatching paradise**, a vast array of exciting birds can be found in the park with over 470 bird species recorded.

Spend your days exploring your surrounds on game drives and walking safaris before retreating to the comforts of the Camp.





Mana Pool National Park

The Mana Pools National Park is a **remote and pristine destination** tucked away within the middle of the Zambezi Valley.

The Unesco-awarded Mana Pools National Park offers exciting game drives, walking safaris, canoe safaris and river cruises that allow to view an abundance of wildlife and learn much about animals behaviours.

The Mana Pool is home to more than 350 bird species due to the floodplains providing the ideal habitat for a great deal of them.
